Chairman's report: The chairman reported that the executive have met bi-monthly to hold the core of the Community Association together and to support the various projects that exist.

Community Travel Plan: See written report. However, hot off the press is the news that 90/92 Green Street is finally going to have a footpath in front of it (residents have given up some of their garden to allow this to happen) so that people no longer have to walk in the road. There is now a compulsory speed limit of 20 miles in the area. Permit parking is going to be introduced in Park Street.

It was reported that up to £3,000 is available for community ventures from the community development fund from the city council.
